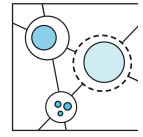

## Getting there and away

If you come by car – there is limited free parking on site – first come, first serve. Alternatively, there is a public parking garage in the village center, about 10 minutes walking distance. Be aware that the conditions may be according to the season – frosty and potentially snow/ice on the roads. Winter tires are mandatory. Please note that in particular the last 200m can be tricky after snowfall!!

The best alternative way to get there is to fly to Innsbruck Airport or take a train to Ötztal Bahnhof (train station). Currently, direct or connecting flights serve Innsbruck from: Vienna, Frankfurt, Amsterdam, Rotterdam, Eindhoven, Brussels London (Gatwick, Heathrow, Luton), Manchester, Paris.

From there, we will help to arrange joint shuttle transfers, if you provide final details by December 29<sup>th</sup>. If you are a TRR353 member, please provide travel details to Paola Ripani. All others, please use this link to update your travel details.
